Seminar on

"Legal Aspects of NEC3 Contracts: Principles and Practice"

Successfully Held on 10 November 2017

The use of NEC3 contracts for public procurement is gaining much momentum in Hong Kong. With the innovation and principles of early warnings, compensation events and risk management procedures adopted, the legal principles and realities shown from decided cases overseas are of useful guidance to those in Hong Kong adopting or planning to adopt the NEC3 on a wider spectrum of projects.

This seminar aims at providing a critical review and update of the legal cases concerning the use of NEC3 contracts based on experience overseas. Through discussion of real lessons learnt, the law and practice on areas that those involved need to be alerted to be highlighted.
