"Legal Aspects of Variations in Construction Contracts"

Variations invariably exist in construction contracts. It is a matter of degree and extent of their implications to the overall project delivery. As such, the legal issues surrounding such variations need proper understanding. A variation order is a common agreement in construction projects, which involves an amendment of the original scope of work as in the contract. This may include adding or subtracting work, increasing or decreasing the quantity of work, changing the character or quality of material or work.

This seminar provides the legal concepts of variations in construction contracts. By reviewing recent representative cases, it equips participants with the necessary knowledge and practical understanding for managing variations in their work environment.
