

Webinar on Tort Law in Public Health Context in Hong Kong

Tort law encompasses aspects of negligence and liabilities of occupiers and employers that concerns management of businesses and government entities. In the context of public health issues, the guiding principles must be properly understood for avoiding legal traps and pitfalls in various business and public settings and for managing liabilities and risks.

This online training aims at equipping participants with the necessary knowledge and practical skills for managing such risks and liabilities. By reviewing recent cases, the legal principles of tortuous liabilities and their implications in practice upon the effective administration in the business settings are examined.
